As February comes to a close, we want to take a moment to reflect on all the wonderful experiences we've shared in our Children's House classroom this month. Here's a recap of what we've been up to:



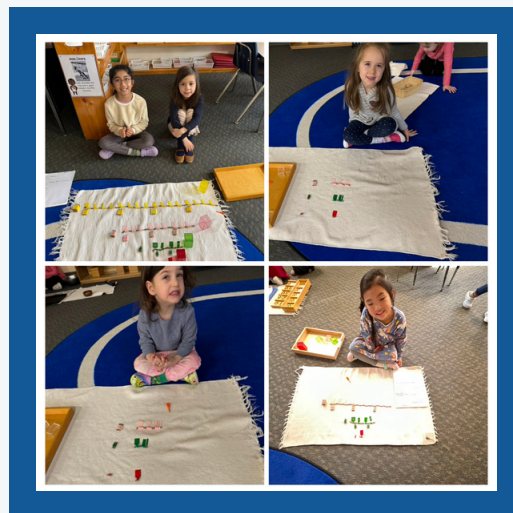
Valentine's Day Celebration:

Language:

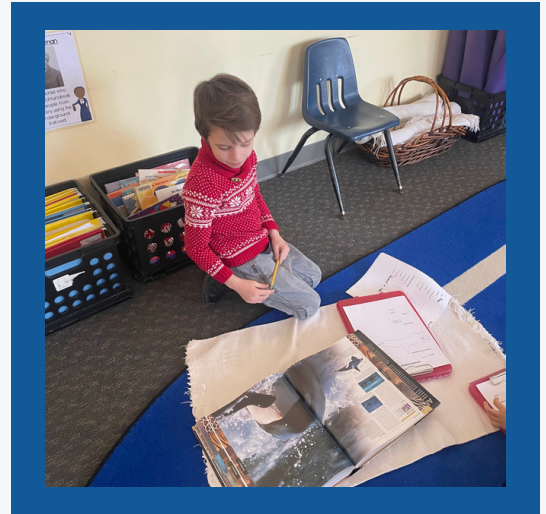
