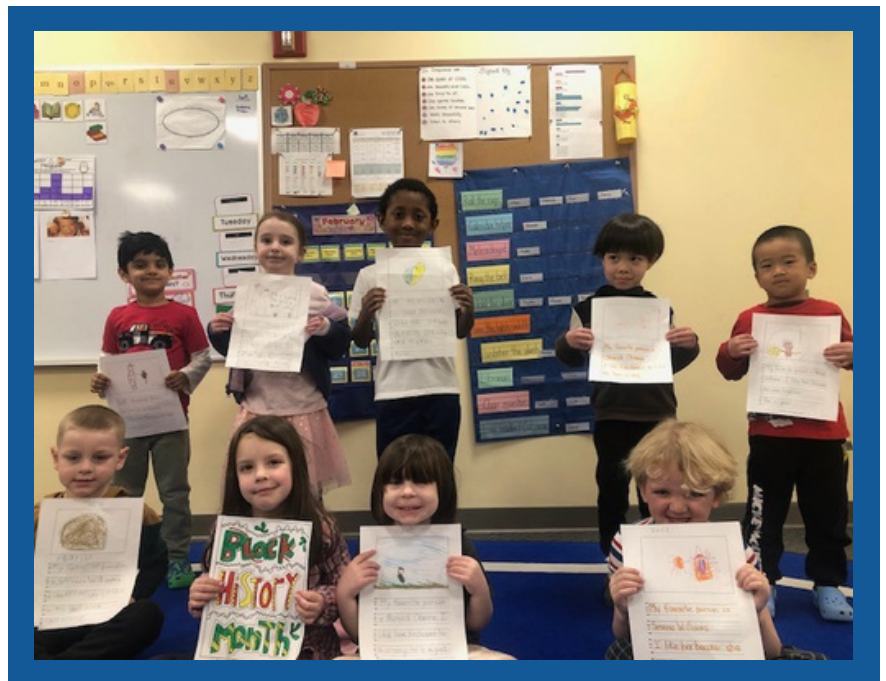

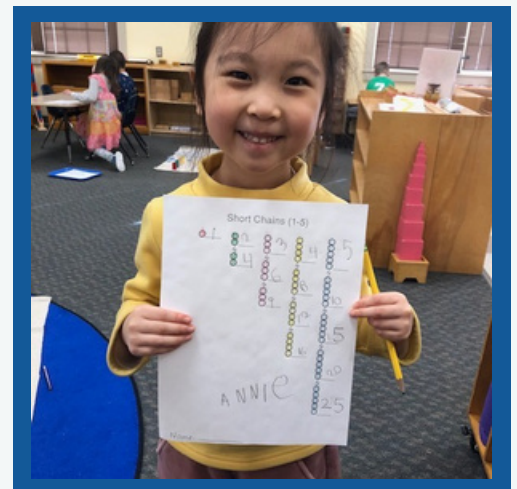


## Valentine's Day

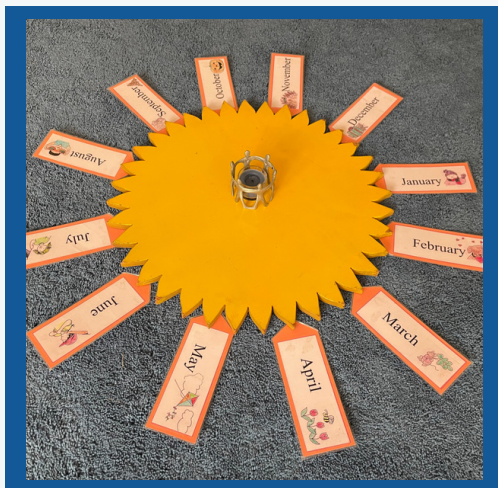
