Math

Everyone in Dove is working with fractions. First years are focused on learning the concept of fractions while second years review what they learned last year before they start adding fractions and finding equivalency. Third years are working on subtraction with like denominators and division with whole numbers. We will be continuing to work on fractions into March and some students are curious to find out more about unlike denominators, mixed numbers, and improper fractions.





Language

Persuasive Writing is our next writing topic. As opinion writing and persuasive writing are connected, we always work to teach them in sequence in our classroom. Students were able to take what they know about giving their opinion and work on persuading their reader to their side. They could choose to convince their teachers, parents, or friends.

Cultural




STEM
