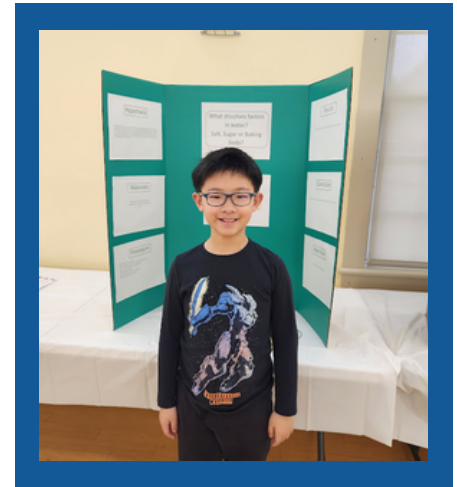
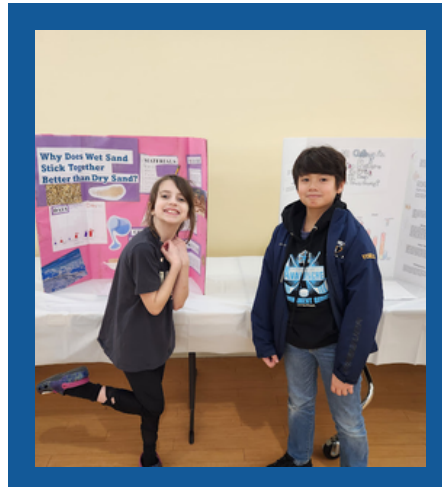

The third year students did a wonderful job presenting for the Science Fair. They worked hard and diligently to choose a question that they wanted to find more information about, formed a hypothesis, gathered their materials and research, created a procedure, and formed a conclusion based off their procedure. To continue their study of the Composition of the Earth, the students learned about three different plate boundaries. They learned about divergent, convergent, and transform boundaries. As an extension to the activity, the students were able to use graham crackers and shaving cream to create the different boundaries and observe how they move.

Math

In math, the students have been working with various Montessori materials to practice their skills. Pictured to the right, Anuj is working on dynamic division using a 1-digit divisor. The students have also been working with fractions. The first years worked on ordering fractions from a whole to tenth. The second years worked on adding fractions with the same denominator. The third years worked on subtracting fractions with uncommon denominators.



Language

In language, the first years continued their study of grammar and worked with adjectives. The second years worked on learning the parts of a dictionary and how to find definitions. The third years continued their study of sentence analysis and learned to identify the subject, predicate, and direct object in a sentence.

Cultural

In biology, the students are starting their study of classification. They started off by learning about what makes an organism living or non-living. They learned how to reference an acronym called Mrs. Ferg to help them remember what makes something alive. They will continue their study of classification and the animal kingdoms over the next few weeks.





Poetry

In preparation for our Author's Tea in April, the students began learning about different types of poetry and writing their own poems. So far they have learned about acrostic, alliteration, season poem, and an I Am poem. They will continue to learn about various forms of poetry and create a booklet of poems.
