Math

In Geometry, the first years have finished their study of various types of lines. They learned about skew lines that are represented on different planes of solid shapes. The second year students learned about the addition of angles using the Montessori Protractor and Montessori Fraction Circles. The third year students have continued to learn more about quadrilaterals and they learned about the set theory of quadrilaterals.





Cultural

In our cultural studies, the students have been learning about the country United States of America. They have learned about the states and their capitals. As an extension to that study, the students have also been learning about the different presidents of the USA and the order of their presidency using the President Card Sort. The students have enjoyed engaging with this material and they have also learned a song about the presidents as well.

Language

Our students have been learning new skills in grammar. The third years have been learning more about prepositions and they have been practicing building sentences with prepositions using our Small Environment. The second year students have been working on identifying concrete and abstract nouns and they have learned the new grammar symbol for that type of noun. The first year students have been introduced to grammar and the noun. They have been identifying nouns in our environment to help aid in their understanding.





STEM

In STEM, the students have finished the playdough process and they are now learning about agricultural engineering. The students have been posed with a problem about pollinating plants. They are going to have to create a hand pollinator which will replace an insect to help plants to grow. They will be using the Engineering Design Process to help guide them through this new STEM kit.
