Practical Life

In the practical life area, we introduce activities that promote children's independence. These activities include hand washing, rolling and unrolling a work rug, walking around a rug, and learning how to carry a work item and return it to its place after completion. The children have also been practicing pouring and scooping, which helps them learn to serve themselves independently.



Sensorial: Rough and Smooth

The children used various seashells to explore and distinguish between rough and smooth textures. This activity enhances their concentration and independence while expanding their vocabulary.



Language: Sandpaper Letters

The Sandpaper Letters are designed to help children prepare for writing by tracing textured letters. This activity reinforces their muscle memory for writing the letters correctly and helps them remember the shapes of the letters. As they trace each letter, they also hear and repeat its phonetic sound.





Science: Fish

This month, we focused on learning about fish. We began by exploring the different parts of a fish using three-part matching cards, puzzles, and creating our own books. We discussed how fish breathe with gills instead of lungs like humans do. Additionally, we looked at various types of fish and sea creatures.

Math: Sets Basket

Sets baskets consist of 55 objects for numbers 1-10. The child picks an object and groups them together. After carefully counting the objects, the child puts them under the corresponding number. This activity helps develop logic, order, and reasoning. This month, we had beautiful materials that you would find at the beach.
